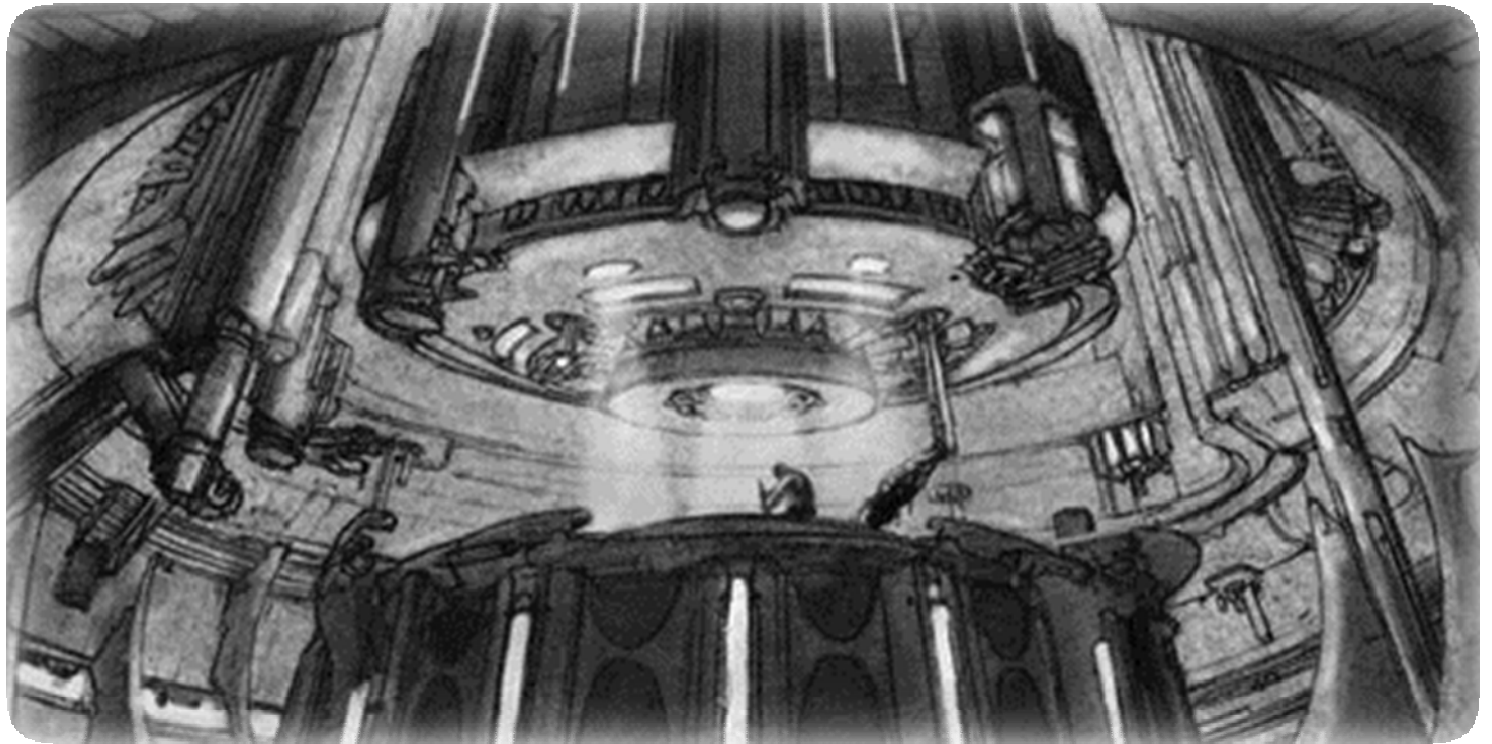

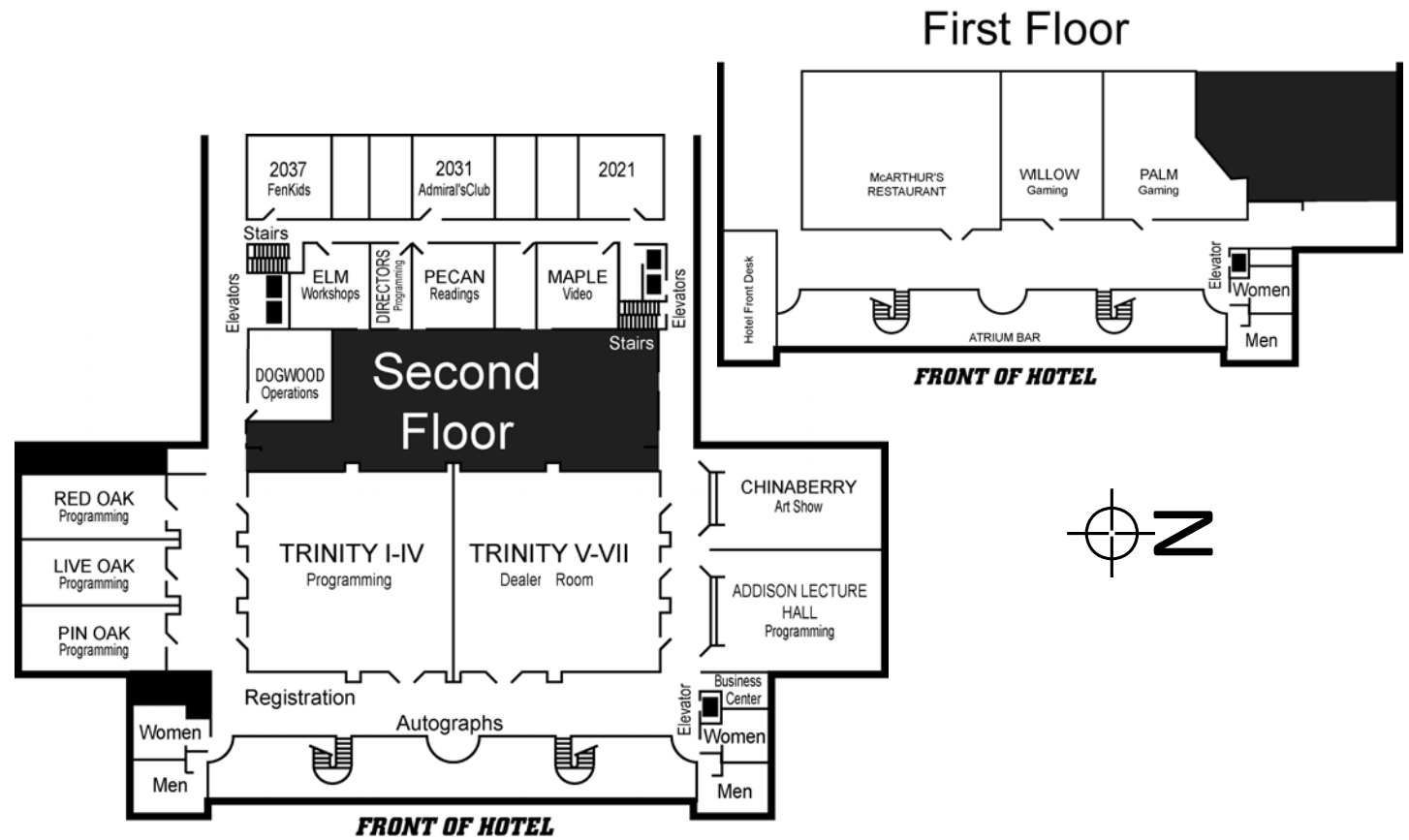

FenCon Rules and Etiquette

FenCon expects its members to respect each other and behave in a generally civilized fashion. Members should respect common sense rules for public behavior, personal interaction, common courtesy, and respect for private property. If you wouldn't do it at home, please don't do it here. In addition, we have a few specific rules for all members to follow:

1. IDENTIFY YOURSELF (BADGES): Each FenCon member is provided with a badge. Your badge is your permit into all the convention events and functions. Wear your badge so it is visible at all times. Anyone seen without a badge in any of our function rooms will be asked to leave. If you find someone's badge or lose your own badge, please contact Registration or Convention Operations. Lost badges may require the purchase of a new membership.

2. SAFETY FIRST: We want everyone to have a great time, but we will not tolerate dangerous, illegal, or threatening behavior. Please report to the convention committee any incidents in which a member of the convention is abusive, insulting, intimidating, bothersome, or acting in an unsafe or illegal manner.

Harassing or threatening behavior should be reported at once to Operations or the nearest FenCon staff member. The FenCon Executive Committee will evaluate the situation and take appropriate action, up to and including removing the offender from the convention.

Persons violating the law may be turned over to the police or hotel security. FenCon reserves the right to revoke the membership and badge of any person or persons whose behavior is deemed to be detrimental to the convention as a whole. Refunds for revoked memberships are at the sole discretion of the FenCon Chair.

In the event of a medical emergency, please go directly to the hotel staff, not the convention staff – either the front desk or the nearest hotel staff member. The hotel has asked that all attendees go directly to them in these situations.

- 3. YOU ARE HERE (HOTEL):** Please be courteous to all guests of the hotel. We are not the only people or event here this weekend. So let's all get along and have a great time. Please observe all rules posted by the hotel.
- 4. CHILDREN:** FenCon is an event that is fun for the entire family, and we welcome children as attendees. Children of appropriate ages may take part in our FenKids program track. To keep the con experience fun for everyone and to ensure the safety of your children, please watch your children at all times. If they are unable to sit quietly through the excitement of a discussion panel or other event, please take them out in the hallway for a time so they don't interfere with the event or prevent other members from enjoying the full FenCon experience.
- 5. ALCOHOL:** The legal drinking age in Texas is 21 years old. Any minors found in possession of alcohol and any adults found to be providing alcohol to minors will have their memberships revoked and be removed from the convention. No exceptions. Please drink responsibly. If you have had too much, please get a room at the hotel, call a cab, or ask a sober friend for a ride. We want to see you all on Sunday...and at FenCon next year!
- 6. AH, THE ATMOSPHERE:** Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the hotel, including function rooms, sleeping rooms, hallways, and the Admiral's Club (Hospitality Suite). This includes the patio outside the Admiral's Club. Please obey the hotel's posted smoking policies.
- 7. FOOD AND DRINK:** Food or drink is **not** allowed in any convention space except the Admiral's Club.
- 8. HEALTH AND WELFARE (THE 5-2-1 RULE):** Not only for your own comfort, but also to please your fellow fans, follow the 5-2-1 rule of conventions: at least 5 hours of sleep every night, at least 2 meals each day, and at least 1 shower a day.

9. AUTOGRAPHS: Most of our guests are happy to give you their autograph, but please follow these simple rules: When possible, only request autographs during the designated autograph sessions. If there is a line, please limit yourself to 3 items to be autographed per guest. Please do not ask any guests for an autograph as they are leaving or going to a panel, or while they are at a meal.

10. WEAPONS: We know, weapons policies are no fun. But, we don't want the convention to be shut down by the hotel or Addison's finest, so we must have one. Other than during the costume contest, no one is allowed to carry any weapon that would be considered illegal in Texas. A pocketknife is fine. A dagger is not. A *sgian dubh* is fine. A claymore is not. Please use common sense. Any swords, knives, or other weapons purchased in the Dealer Room must be wrapped before leaving the room and taken immediately to your hotel room, car, or other safe place. Yes, you may carry your Official Space Patrol Cosmic Ray Gun.

11. PHOTOGRAPHS, HOLOGRAMS, AND OTHER RENDERINGS: FenCon will not restrict your right to take photos as long as you respect the wishes of your intended subjects. Ask permission before you photograph any individual or group. If someone asks that you not take their picture, please respect their wishes. Also, do not block traffic to take a photo. Move to a less populated area. Asking someone to pose long enough for an oil painting is right out.

12. RECORDING: Recording of performances and programming at FenCon is allowed only for the private use of the person making the recording. If a panelist or performer requests that there be no video or audio taping, please respect his or her wishes.

13. FUN: Everyone attending this convention is required to have fun. Anyone being gloomy or not enjoying the convention may find their molecules scattered across the vastness of space.

Attending FenCon

Getting the Most from This Convention

You've waited through the registration line. You handed money to the convention and they gave you a badge, a book with a pretty cover, and this book, called a Convention Guide. Now what?

First, put your badge on. It is your passport to most of the convention activities, so keep it visible.¹

Second, take a few minutes to review this Convention Guide. It provides a schedule of when the events start and stop and detailed descriptions toward the back of what the panels will cover, when and where.² Think of this convention as a circus: lots of performances happen simultaneously, so there is something happening wherever you look.

Third, read through the descriptions at the back, choose which ones you want to see, then find them on the grid earlier in the book (marking them with a highlighter makes them easier to find later). The grid format lets you scan across the different activities during an hour, making it easier to find conflicts (or, if a panel isn't quite what you wanted, to find alternatives).

You may not be so interested in the panels, but the convention has other activities, too. Take time to enjoy the Art Show, play some games in Gaming, shop for books, jewelry, clothing, accessories, etc. in the Dealer Room, watch movies or shorter videos in the Video Room, or just hang out.

¹ By paying for your membership, you help finance the convention. Although a registered, non-profit 501(c)3 organization, the convention still needs real money to pay for the hotel, airline tickets for the guests, and food for the Hospitality Suite. Showing your badge shows that you've done your part to make this convention happen.

² Wait... what's a panel? Some attendees are happy to meet the Guests of Honor, listen to authors read their own stories or hear how artists put together that really cool piece of art. The convention schedules these discussions and presentations into panels. The Convention Guide describes what the panel topics are and who is on them (as well as concerts, demonstrations, workshops and guest autograph sessions), but also lists when and where they will happen, in the order they will happen.

After the Dealer Room and Art Show close, other conventions and groups often throw parties. On Saturday night you have the All-Star Git-Down Filk-Sing Hootenanny™ and Masquerade, the charity art auctions, and into the wee hours of the morning you may hear strains of music with fannish phrases³ from the filk rooms. If you start to feel run down, you can grab a quick snack or drink in the Admiral's Club, the hospitality room for FenCon. It's a good place where you can sit down and chat with friends, too.

Fourth, activities continue round-the-clock from Friday until the convention closes Sunday afternoon, so pace yourself. Schedule time for eating, drinking, sleeping, and being kind to your fellow convention attendees by taking care of personal hygiene (bathing, etc.).

³ Some terms you may hear around the con but may be new to you:

fan \ˈfän\ *noun* Merriam-Webster lists: an ardent admirer or enthusiast (as of a celebrity or a pursuit) <science-fiction fans>

fen *noun*: The plural form of fan.

fanzine \ˈfän zēn\ *noun* An amateur-produced magazine written for a subculture, usually for little or no compensation (only to defray costs). Original source: fan + magazine

filk \ˈfɪlk\ Music or songs associated with science fiction/fantasy culture. The word was originally a typographical error from 'folk'.

newbie \ˈnü bē\ A person who is new to fandom. We were all new, so don't hesitate to ask someone if something is confusing.

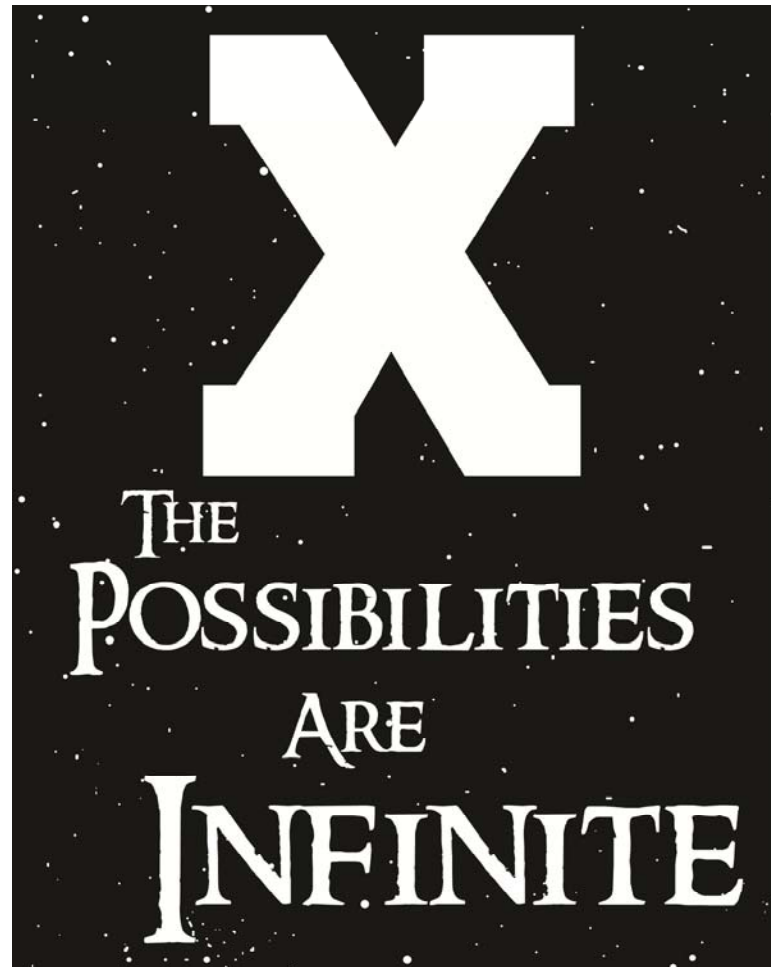
